### **Town of Southington Operational Status as of June 1, 2020:**

As of June 1, 2020, in compliance with the Governor's request. The following is our current condition:

1. All Town departments are now fully staffed with all employees reporting back to work. All Town offices, except the Calendar House, Barnes Museum and Library, will be open to the public beginning June 8<sup>th</sup>. We would like to stress that if you can use our website, email or phone to accomplish what you need from Town offices after June 8<sup>th</sup>, please do so. All residents using the Town offices will be required to have a face mask on at all times.
2. The Library will be open June 8<sup>th</sup> for contactless on demand material pickup and on June 15<sup>th</sup> services will be expanding to wireless printing, summer reading information and limited homebound deliveries. Please visit the Library's website over the next several weeks to review the process.
3. The Barnes Museum will be open beginning June 15<sup>th</sup> for appointments only for groups of four or less. Please call the Barnes Museum for appointments.
4. The Calendar House, although fully staffed, will be operating limited buses and limited lunch deliveries and will be working on limited drop off and pickup of materials but at this time the building will remain closed to the public until further notice.
5. Parks and linear trail including Crescent Lake, have received a large amount of usage. It is important that all residents, when using these areas, maintain social distancing. At Crescent Lake please comply with no parking signage placed by the Police Department. The only way the Town can continue to keep these areas open are to make sure they are used properly. We cannot stress enough we rely on our residence policing themselves and adhering to the social distancing policy.
6. The tennis courts in the Town parks and at Southington High School are now open.
7. The dog park will be open to the public beginning on June 8<sup>th</sup>. Social distancing must be practiced. We rely on our residents to self-police. If this is being abused we will have to reevaluate.
8. Playscapes and basketball courts will reopen to the public on June 5<sup>th</sup>.
9. The Town fields, although never closed during the pandemic, are now expanded to groups of 25 or less. Please be advised, per the Governor directive, no shared equipment should be used.
10. The Town pools are scheduled to open Saturday, June 27<sup>th</sup>. Rules for usage and occupancy limits will be forth coming.
