Apple Pie Baking Contest Information

Date: Saturday, October 1, 2011

Drop off: 8- 10:00 am (no exceptions)

Where: Gazebo on the Southington Main St Town Green

Judging begins at: 11:30 am, near Gazebo

Rules:

1. Pre-registration is required. There is NO registration fee.
2. The first 25 registrants will be accepted.
3. The Contest is open to all residents of Connecticut. You do not have to be a Southington resident to enter.
4. Commercial, Industrial or Professional Bakers, Home Economists, anyone selling bakery products for profit are not eligible to enter.
5. Pre-registration must be received by September 27, 2011
6. Pies will be judged on appearance, flavor and texture. All judges' decisions are final.
7. Apples must be the main pie ingredient.
8. This contest is a local event and not associated with any formal association competition

Entry Day:

1. Bring your pie in a **disposable 8-10 inch pie tin**.
2. Drop off pie **between 8:00 and 10:00 am** at Gazebo at the Town Green
3. Write **recipe on 3 x 5 index card** with your recipe on it.
Do not put your name on the card!
Judges will be reviewing recipe ingredients and process.
4. We cannot return pie plates or containers.
5. Pies will become the property of the Southington Apple Harvest Festival. Slices will be offered for sale to benefit a charity chosen by the Apple Harvest Festival Committee after the judging has concluded.

All prizes are in the form of "gift cards"
