MINUTES OF THE TOWN COUNCIL
OF THE TOWN OF SOUTHLINGTON
SPECIAL MEETING

JUNE 8, 2011

The Town Council held a special meeting on Wednesday, June 8, 2011, at the Fire Headquarters, 310 North Main Street, Southington, Connecticut.

Councilpersons present:

Anthony E. D'Angelo, John C. Dobbins, Dawn A. Miceli, Albert A. Natelli, Jr., Peter J. Romano, Jr. and Stephanie A. Urillo.

Approximately 25 residents were also in attendance.

The meeting convened at 6:00 p.m. A presentation was made by CDM and talked about cost for the Misery Brook sewer shed backups and potential solutions. It was determined that there were no single issues directly attributable to these backups, but that it was an aging infrastructure, primarily clay pipes along Stonegate Road.

CDM's recommendation was to repair 12 manholes and approximately 1900 linear feet of sewer line by slip lining the line, which they believe will resolve 90% of the problems. Additionally, they recommend continuation of the I & I study to the south or downstream area and actions appropriate along those lines.

There were questions and concerns from the audience about slip lining versus pipe replacement, and CDM was resolute in their belief that slip lining was an equally effective and less costly solution. Interaction between staff, CDM and the community was positive, and the meeting was adjourned at 7:00 p.m.
