Call to order at 9:38 am.

### AGENDA

Mr. DellaVecchia moved that the Agenda be corrected under item 2. to replace the month of April with July. Second by Mr. Sciota and approved.

Mr. Sciota, on behalf of himself, Mr. Brumback and Mr. Motes, thanked AMR for their valued assistance during storm Irene.

Mr. DellaVecchia asked if AMR could provide a colored graph which would show ambulance priorities and time involved. Mr. Retallick will see what they can come up with. Mr. DellaVecchia inquired about the turnaround time for meds at Bradley Hospital. Dr. Hobert stated that only the RN is in charge outgoing and returning meds.

At 9:59 am, Mr. Sciota moved to go into Executive Session. Motion was seconded by Mr. DellaVecchia and approved.

A motion to leave Executive Session was made by Mr. DellaVecchia and seconded by Mr. Brumback at 10:33 am. Motion carried.
