The Southington Inland Wetlands Agency held a regular meeting on Thursday, December 2, 2010. Acting Chairman James Sullivan called the meeting to order at 7:00 o'clock, p.m.

Acting Chairman James Sullivan seated Richard Post for Dennis Palmieri for this evening's meeting. A quorum was determined.

**4. Approval of Minutes:** Regular Meeting of November 4<sup>th</sup>, 2010

Mr. Cabata made a motion to approve the Minutes as presented. Mr. DeMello seconded. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote.

**5. Treasurer's Report**

Mr. Cabata gave the Treasurer's Report to date. Mr. DeMello made a motion to approve the report as read. Mr. Post seconded. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote.

**6. Reports from Public, Press and Ex-Officio Members** regarding items scheduled for action.

**7. Inland wetland/Floodplain Filling Applications:**

**A. Information/Action - IW #1183**, application of Alan Wells seeking to install a water main within Rte. 322 and to span Judd Brook with said water line. Property located in the vicinity of 2110 Meriden Waterbury Tpke. And Judd Brook.

Mr. Lavallee reported the engineers on this project are still working with the State and the water department to resolve the issue of the crossing of the brook. At this point, they request a table and they will need a 65-day extension which they have also requested.

Mr. Cabata made a motion to table #1183. Mr. DeMello seconded. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote.

Mr. DeMello made a motion to grant the 65-day extension to #1183. Mr. Post seconded. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote.

Mr. Cyr requested that the Pledge of Allegiance be added to this Agenda for all future meetings.
