

**TOWN OF SOUTHLINGTON  
PARKING AUTHORITY  
Regular Meeting  
October 4, 2007**

A regular meeting of the Parking Authority of the Town of Southington was held on October 4, 2007 at 4:30 pm in the Town Council Chambers of the Southington Town Hall at 75 Main Street, Southington, Connecticut. The meeting was called to order by Rebecca Davis, Chairperson.

**Roll Call**

A quorum was determined.

**Approval of Minutes of September 6, 2007.**

Mr. Myers made a motion to approve the Minutes of the September 6, 2007 meeting. Mr. Jones seconded. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote.

The Chair reported she spoke with Officer Mullins regarding the Congregational Church, which we'll discuss under New Business.

**Submission of Bills and Payments**

Stenographer bill for 106.29. Mr. Jones made a motion to pay it. Mr. Myers seconded. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote.

Bill from the end of August from John Meade for the monthly maintenance for \$280. Mr. Myers made a motion to approve payment for John Meade. Mr. Jones seconded. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote.

## **Old Business**

### **Parking Lot Issues**

The Chair brought up the building demolished and Mr. DelBuono was going to have our handicapped signs back up. And, also he had debris in the lot longer than he was supposed to. I'd like to put my letter into the Minutes. (Chairman Davis has the letter.) I think you guys all got the letter just kind of putting him on notice that if something comes up again, we have a paper trail. And, we'll know how to proceed.

The handicapped signs are back up.

Commissioner Salmeri and Mr. Jones did have a conversation with the Town Attorney about the 98 Main Street lot to be sure that he followed through with what we had. But I guess it's as we discussed. It's standard procedure, he does it right for two weeks and then you've got to get back on him again.

The Chair and Mr. Myers agreed there is a change.

Mr. Jones reported the Kiwanis is finished with the parking lot. They put a chain, put big boulders in and flowers around the island. We took down a tree and put a walkway across from that walkway that comes from the Praline area. We put a walkway across the island so you can get through there. We're pretty much done.

The Chair suggested sending a thank you letter. Mr. Jones said he'd do that.

Mr. Myers examined the lot in Plantsville. It doesn't look in that bad a shape. I know that's one of our next priorities, but I didn't see a sinkhole. It didn't look like it was in that critical shape. Mr. Jones agreed, as did the Chair.

## **New Business**

### **Congregational Church**

The Chair reported a vote of confidence was done to allow the Congregational Church to park. They usually park in the rear of the D'Angelo lot. A couple of times a year they ask to use that for 20 or less cars while they go on one of their overnight ventures.

This year they asked for the Riccio lot and tucked their cars away in the rear of the lot because the D'Angelo lot was being used. They needed the answer before a next meeting. We did do a vote of confidence. Maybe we could have a vote now if someone wants to make a motion.

Mr. Jones made a motion to approve it but make them aware we're not going to be responsible for any damage. Mr. Myers seconded. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote.

Mr. Myers made a motion to adjourn. Mr. Jones seconded. Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote.
