

TOWN OF SOUTHLINGTON
PARKING AUTHORITY
SPECIAL MEETING
OCTOBER 8, 2008

A special meeting of the Parking Authority of the Town of Southington was held on October 8, 2008 at 4:00 pm in the municipal parking lots of the Town of Southington. The meeting was called to order in the rear of the Fleet Municipal Lot by Rebecca Davis, Chairperson.

Roll Call

Mr. Myers, Ms. Zommer, Mrs. Zoni, and Ms. Davis were present.

A quorum was determined.

Fleet Municipal Lot Dumpsters

The Parking Authority met with the Town Engineer to review a potential site for a cluster dumpster placement. The Town Engineer will investigate any easements or right of ways in potential site. He will also walk the lot in the near future to see of any other possibilities in this lot.

Walk of 98 Main Street

As requested by Matt Florian, the Parking Authority met him in lot and reviewed the two hour parking areas. The Parking Authority agreed additional 2 hour parking in this lot is and will be needed. Motion by Linda Zommer to have a Public Hearing to add 9 - 2 hour parking spaces to 98 Main Street Lot from the hours of 8 am to 6pm and seconded by John Myers. Motion passed on voice vote.

Signage in Fleet Lot

The Fleet Lot is a leased lot to the Town of Southington. The chairperson of the Parking Authority received a call from the Bank of America (formerly Fleet Bank) and was told of complaints from their customers. They're unable to find a spot in the lot to park and go to the bank. This began in September when apparently the overflow of students from Branford Hall started to park in a vast section of this lot. Motion made by John Myers to add to Public Hearing addition of 7 – 2 hour parking spaces in the smaller lot of the Fleet Lot from the hours of 8 am to 6 pm and seconded by Susan Zoni. Motion passed on voice vote.

Two Hour signage in the Riccio Way Lot

The Parking Authority walked the Riccio Way Lot to review its motion to add rather than remove 2 hour parking from this lot. This motion needs to go to Public Hearing. Mrs. Zoni motioned to add 22 - 2 hour parking to the first double row of parking in the Riccio Way Lot from 8 am to 6 pm with the removal of 15- 2 hour parking spaces facing into the D'Angelo Lot and seconded by Ms. Zommer. Motion passed on voice vote.

Adjournment

Ms. Zommer made a motion to adjourn and Mr. Myers seconded. Motion passed on a voice.

The meeting adjourned at 5:00 pm.
