Peter Talbot shared via email that Frontier will be making changes to simplify access to Public, Education and Government (PEG) programming in Connecticut. Currently, PEG programming is accessible via the Channel 99 application. Beginning on or around February 14, 2018, PEG programming will be transitioned to specific channels:

6007 – Cheshire Public Access – PATV15

6008 – Cheshire Educational Access 16

6009 – Cheshire Town Government 14

6039 – Meriden Education Access

6040 – Meriden City Government Access

6083 – Southington ED TV

6084 – Southington Government Access

The Channel 99 application will be available for approximately 30 days following the launch of the new channel lineup, and content will be available on both the specific channel and the Channel 99 application. Thereafter, the Channel 99 application will no longer be available.
