August 29th Meeting

Chapter 15 – Planning

- Sec 15-41 change composed of 12 town residents to composed of 10 people as set forth in CT State Statue
- Sec 15-44 – Change the commission shall submit in March of each year a written annual report to – the commission shall submit a yearly annual report to the town council of its activities with appropriate recommendations for improving the economic condition of the town.
- Article IV, Section 15-61 – delete
- Section 15-121 – change the chief elected official of the municipality to Town Council Chair or his/her designee
- Change legislative body to Town Council consistently throughout the Ordinances

Chapter 16 –Police

- Delete sections 16.1, 16-2, 16-3, 16-4 and 16-5
- Replace Article II, Alarm Systems with Alarm Permits will be issued by the Southington Police Department based upon the rules and regulations posted on their website as well as the town's website

Chapter 17 – Streets and Sidewalks

- The Town Manager reported that upon further research, the qualifications for residential sidewalks are realistic and in agreement with neighboring towns.

- School Access sidewalks will be further discussed at our next meeting after a meeting with the Board of Education and Town Government to understand school needs.
- Sec 17-56 – change town engineer to local traffic authority or his designee
- Sec 17 – 131 and 17-132 change tree warden to highway department
- Sec 17-171 (e) End paragraph with The Town Council’s decision shall be final
