MINUTES of the Meeting of the Board of Police Commissioners held at the Southington Police Department on February 9, 2012.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Pestillo at 6:00 p.m.

Commissioners Verderame, DePaola, Montague, and Bedard were present.

Chief Daly, Captain Simone, and Captain Palmieri were present.

- 1. The Pledge of Allegiance** was led by Commissioner Verderame.
- 2. Approval of Minutes.** Motion made by Commissioner Montague to approve the minutes of the Regular Meeting of January 12, 2012, seconded by Commissioner Bedard. All in favor. Motion passes.

1. 總論

最後，我們應加強教育與社會之聯繫。教育不應是封閉於象牙塔內之活動，而應與社會發展緊密相連。學校應加強與企業、社區之合作，開展實踐教育，培養學生之社會責任感與實踐能力。同時，社會各界也應尊重教育規律，營造良好之教育氛圍，為教育事業之發展提供有力支持。只有教育與社會相互促進、共同發展，才能為我國之繁榮昌盛培養出更多優秀人才。

Regular Meeting after Executive Session

Chairman Pestillo called the Regular Meeting after Executive Session to order at 6:57 p.m.

Present: Commissioners Verderame, DePaola, Montague, Bedard, and Chief Daly.

B. Commissioner Communications. Chairman Pestillo made mention of the success of the Polar Plunge. He also informed the Commission of Dr. Henry Lee speaking at the University of New Haven on March 15th at 5:00 p.m. and the STEPS Forum being held on March 7th at the Aqua Turf.

C. Communications from the Administration.

4. SPD Activity Report. Captain Palmieri gave an overview of the activity report from December 2011 which showed a 34% increase in NIBRS due to, but not limited to, vandalism, thefts, and thefts from motor vehicles.

5. Bills Submitted for Payment. Motion made by Commissioner Montague to approve the bills submitted for payment as presented by Chief Daly, seconded by Commissioner Bedard. All in favor. Motion passes.

6. Report to the Commission by Chief Daly.

A. Parking Tag Appeals. Motion made by Commissioner Montague to approve the parking tag appeals as presented and as recommended by Lt. Pocock, seconded by Commissioner Bedard. All in favor. Motion passes.

B. Awards General Order Amendment. Lt. Pocock presented the Commission with an overview of changes and additions to the Awards General Order. Motion made by Commissioner Montague to add Item 6D to the agenda to include and combine all SPD Awards for the purpose of the vote, seconded by Commissioner Verderame. All in favor. Motion passes.

6 D. Motion made by Commissioner Montague to accept the changes and additions to the Awards General Order 100.26.3 as presented by Lt. Pocock, seconded by Commissioner Verderame. All in favor. Motion passes.

- C. Uniform General Order Amendment.** Lt. Pocock presented additions and changes to the Uniform General Order Amendment. Commissioner Montague questioned whether or not the Police Department had a policy in place for officer's wearing a police patch or uniform off duty. Lt. Pocock has suggested speaking with the Town Attorney and with the Chief's permission research the issue.

Motion made by Commissioner Montague to accept the recommended changes made to General Order 100.50 for uniforms approved as presented by Lt. Pocock, seconded by Commissioner Verderame.

Commissioner Montague questioned whether or not the Police Department had a policy in place for officer's wearing a police patch or uniform off duty. Lt. Pocock has suggested speaking with the Town Attorney and with the Chief's permission research the issue.

Chairman Pestillo asked for a vote on the motion pending under discussion regarding General Order 100.50. All in favor. Motion passes.

Commissioner DePaola added that it is sometimes taken for granted on the amount of time our officers put in during emergencies due to storms that the public is not aware of and commended the police personnel on the excellent job they did specifically related to the October 29th, 2011 storm that occurred in town. Chairman Pestillo added that the problems resulting from the storm were hardly noticeable due to the efficiency of the work performed by the personnel that day.

7. Old Business

- A. Prescription Drug Drop Box.** Chairman Petillo asked that this item be moved to next month's agenda as he would like to gather more information to present to the Commission.

8. New Business

Sgt. DePalma asked Chairman Pestillo that Items A and B be switched in order to present the two items in a more efficient manner. Upon approval from the Chairman Sgt. DePalma went forward with his agenda.

- B. SPD Community Services Presentation. Sgt. DePalma brought the Commission up to date with the activity within the Community Services Division such as the School Resource Officer, the Dare Program, the Drug Task Force, and the Juvenile Review Board. He also commented on the Playing by the Rules Program which is focused at the Middle School Level and Lock Down Procedures at the High School, Middle Schools, and Alta. Sgt. DePalma continued that discussions are about to begin regarding the possibility of lock down procedures being implemented into the Elementary Schools.

- A. STEPS Presentation. Sgt. DePalma presented the Commission with the history of the STEPS Program from its initiation to present day. He explained that STEPS is a community coalition that was established to coordinate a response to the risky behavior of our youth involving community leaders. Sgt. DePalma showed a video which was very informative regarding all aspects of this program after which a discussion was held.

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
