- iii) Trench program changes – Making changes so that contractor can due permanent patch vs having temporary patch that will have to be redone later (KH)
- iv) RFQ Trail Extension – Lazy Lane to West queen 80% federal funded, looking into 20% funded by State, Pros and cons (KH)
- v) Renovations first phase to include Streetlight, benches, Trash Bins being repaired and painted. \$14,300. Work to start after AHF.
