Rules:

- All entries must be submitted by the contest deadline: **September 20, 2021**
- Include the author’s first and last name, school, grade, home address, and a parent/guardian’s daytime phone number
- In addition, please include the nominated grandmother’s first and last name

Judging:

A panel of judges will select the best essay and the winning grandmother will be designated the “Granny Apple” of the 52nd Apple Harvest Festival. The winning author’s family will be notified by phone. The winner and grandmother will be introduced during the Festival’s opening ceremonies and will appear in the parade.

Essays must be received by September 20, 2021. They may be submitted by mail to the address below or hand-delivered to the Recreation Department office in the Southington Town Hall.
