



INTERSTATE 84 IN SOUTHINGTON, CT

CLOSED ONE WEEKEND

Use Alternates Routes from June 27 to June 30, 2014



The Connecticut Department of Transportation is replacing two bridges carrying Interstate 84 Eastbound and Westbound over Marion Avenue in Southington, CT. The work is being done using Accelerated Bridge Construction (ABC) which uses innovative planning, design, materials, and construction methods to reduce the onsite construction time and long term impacts that are normally present when rehabilitating or replacing bridge structures.

I-84 will be closed in both directions at Exit 30, Marion Avenue, for one weekend starting at 9 p.m. Friday, June 27 to 5 a.m. Monday, June 30. Rain dates are July 11 to July 14, 2014.

Heavy traffic delays are expected and motorists are encouraged to plan ahead and seek alternate routes. Suggested alternate routes include I-91, I-691, and Route 9.

Local detours are established for residents and businesses in the area surrounding the construction site and signs will be posted. Any thru traffic on I-84 will be detoured off Exit 30, Marion Avenue, and brought back onto I-84 at the on ramps located at same interchange.
