The Veteran organizations from Southington will hold a joint Flag raising ceremony at the Southington Care Center at 9:00AM.

Times given are approximate and may vary slightly.

Participants of this year's Annual Memorial Day Parade are to form at Derynoski Elementary School's lower parking lot on Eden Ave., between 9:45 AM and 10:15 AM step off at 10:30 AM.

The parade will take the following route;

entering Eden Ave., proceeding west to Liberty St., right (north), on to Liberty St., proceeding through the intersection at Columbus Ave., continuing onto the intersection at Center St., right (east, against traffic) onto Center St., proceeding to the town green, again turning right onto Apple Way passing Post-72, continuing to Columbus Ave., making the final right hand turn (west) on to Columbus Ave., where the participating school bands, civic organizations and local groups will disband and disperse.

A Ceremony honoring Veterans will be held immediately following the parade in front of the American Legion Home, at 64 Main St. Southington CT.
