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This email is from Richard Tanguay residing at 1597 Meriden Avenue, Southington, CT. In reference to SPU#643 meeting to be held on February 2nd, 2021.

I have three concerns about the car wash proposed which I hope are at least addressed at the hearing.

First is a term called "Stacking" which refers to cars lined up in the street waiting to enter a business location which would be the car wash in this case. We already have a stacking problem at certain times of the day or week at that intersection with cars trying to get into the Dunkin Donuts located there.

Second, I hope the noise level is reasonable pertaining to vacuums to vacuum out the cars and the blowers if they are used to dry cars off exiting the car wash building.

Third, and most important to me is water coming out of the beds of pickup trucks exiting the car wash especially if the trucks are heading east bound after leaving the car wash. There is an uphill grade heading east and if trucks have water in there beds while entering the street there could be an icing problem in both lanes of traffic during the winter months similar to what happens at the car wash located at the intersection of Old Turnpike Road and Route 322 in Milldale.

Because the speed limit is either 40 or 45 mph on that road, icing at that traffic light could cause accidents when vehicles traveling on those roads can't stop or take off because of icing. Who would be responsible for sanding that area if there is icing which isn't weather related?
