Good Evening Rob,

A couple of comments for the meeting tonight.

The current regulations are not appropriate for our community. Decisions about who can or can't have these kind of systems are being made inconsistently. There is not yet a standard that applies, so we are proposing to establish parameters that are fair to our community members who want solar, and reasonable for the Town.

This needs to be decided in a timely fashion, as in THIS month, because there's a sizable rebate at stake (over \$6,000).

I have some data associated with ground mounted solar PV systems in other Towns. I have installed ground mounted systems as follows in the past several years.

- 48 panels in Mansfield Center (in a Wetland Buffer)
- 44 panels in Litchfield
- 44 panels in Sherman
- 36 panels in Cheshire

In addition, the CT Green Bank has approved a rebate for the following systems recently:

- 80 panels in Pomfret
- 80 panels in Pomfret
- 130 panels in Middlebury
- 66 panels in Ellington
