The Town of Plainville is looking to replace two 36” culverts under Town Line Road which will have the flared ends in Southington.

1. Could the pump-around diversion be the preferred method of water removal? Is there a particular reason water is being allowed to flow through the construction area/existing pipes while the new pipes are being installed? A straw bale check dam upstream should be able to contain flow with the pump-around method.
2. An expanded plunge pool at the downstream outlets could provide mitigation for floodplain fill.
